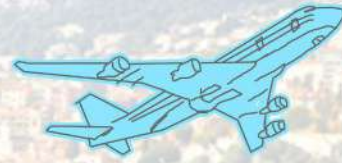

Next travel to the world-famous gambling destination, Monaco. Visit the Monaco Cathedral - resting place of Monaco's kings and late Princess Grace. Continue to the Royal Palace Plaza, where you can see the scenery of the Côte d'Azur.

DAY 4 Cannes-Gorges du Verdon

Once a quaint fishing village, Cannes is currently one of the most glamorous attractions on the Côte d'Azur. Nestled on the crescent of the Gulf of Napoule with a pleasant Mediterranean climate, Cannes is the second largest city in the Alpes-Maritimes department. It hosts around a million foreign tourists per year and is renowned for the coveted Cannes Film Festival.

The Gorges du Verdon is one of the most beautiful canyon in Europe. The Verdon River flows from the Alps in an "S" shape through this 700-meter-deep gorge, which stretches for tens of kilometres, making it one of the most amazing mountain scenes in Provence. It is a paradise on earth for all who visit it.

DAY 5 Aix en Provence-Les Baux de Provence Les carrières de lumières

Aix-en-Provence, the former capital of Provence, is a medieval city with boulevards, fountains and magnificent houses, the most "metropolitan" area of Provence. It has been the cultural, economic and intellectual centre of Provence since the 12th century and the home of the talented painter Paul Cézanne.

Les Baux, perched on a limestone cliff 245 meters high, is an exquisite mountain town in Provence. Built in 950 A.D., the entire town was carved entirely out of stone and still retains its medieval style. The town's church, hospital, town hall and stores are all centuries old.

Next visit Les Carrières de Lumières, which is an "immersive digital experience" art centre. The exhibition has not only caused an international sensation, but also started a global trend of immersive digital art.

DAY 6 Fontaine de Vaucluse -Gordes-Roussillon

Fontaine de Vaucluse is a small town in Provence at the foot of high cliffs. The Sorgue River flows out of these cliffs and picturesquely crosses the town to the amazement of the visiting tourists.

Gordes is a French village, also known as the "City in the Sky". The houses in the village are built using stones, and are located on top of the entire mountain, which is known as the most beautiful village in France. Gordes is also famous for being the setting of the movie "A Good Year".

The red mountain town of Roussillon, named after the colourful mineral pigments produced in the region has become a fairy-tale tourist destination. As you walk through the narrow alleys of the village, you can see the small houses along the roadside painted in different beautiful colours, with the medieval walls that surround them, against the pure turquoise blue sky and white clouds of Provence, it is like a dreamy watercolour painting.

DAY 7 Pont du gard-Arles

The Pont du Gard is one of the must-see tourist attractions in the south of France, where visitors from all over the world come every year to admire this architectural gem of Roman civilization. It is the largest surviving ancient Roman aqueduct in the world. The local people play water rafting here, and it is also a place suitable for vacation, boating, swimming, catching fish etc.

Arles, a city in the south of France in the Rhône region, is home to the ruins of ancient Rome, a United Nations-listed World Heritage Site. Arles was also a city where the painter Vincent Van Gogh lived for nearly 15 months before being driven to a sanatorium in Saint-Rémy by the Arles residents. During his time in Arles, Van Gogh created over 300 paintings, including "Café Terrace at Night", "The Bedroom in Arles", and "Starry Night Over the Rhône".

Lyon, which is the third largest city in France, is full of art and culture. The old town is full of beautiful historical buildings: the Roman theatre, churches, astronomical clocks, etc. Strolling through the streets, you will often encounter large painted murals, which are full of surprises. The Lyon Old Town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is a popular destination for tourists, with its vibrant universities, shopping centres, old markets, and cobblestoned streets.

Geneva's Old Town is also a unique tourist attraction, where you can stroll and shop in the narrow streets. The most striking landmark of the city is a fountain in Lake Geneva with a 140 meter high water column that can be seen from many parts of the city. A cruise on the the romantic and beautiful Lake Léman will be arranged during the visit.
