Day 1

-Assemble at airport to take an international flight to the British capital, London. Upon arrival, there will be a dedicated person to pick you up and assist with checking into a local hotel for rest.

Day 2 London

08:00 - Hotel breakfast

09:00 - Full-day cityscape sightseeing:

-Westminster Abbey: The place where the coronation and enthronement of the British kings take place. It holds a supreme position in the UK and has hosted almost all royal coronations, weddings, and major ceremonies since 1066. It also features iconic landmarks such as Big Ben, the Houses of Parliament, and the London Eye, the world's first and formerly the largest observation wheel, standing at a total height of 135 meters (443 feet) on the south bank of the River Thames in Lambeth, facing Westminster City with the Houses of Parliament and Big Ben. Other notable stops include Whitehall, 10 Downing Street (the Prime Minister's residence), the Royal Horse Guards Parade, the Queen's residence, Buckingham Palace, and St. James's Royal Park.

12:00 - Lunch

13:00 - Visit Trafalgar Square and the British Museum with a Chinese interpreter. The British Museum is one of the oldest, most extensive, and famous museums globally, showcasing a vast and diverse collection of artifacts and treasures from around the world, making it exceptional among museums worldwide.

18:00 - Dinner

19:00 - Check into the local hotel for rest.





Day 3 London

08:00 - Hotel breakfast

09:00 - Depart by car to the Thames River Cruise*:

-Cruise the Thames, linking London landmarks: London Eye, Millennium Bridge, Tower of London, Tower Bridge, Big Ben, Westminster, and Greenwich Village's Royal Observatory.

-Discover the Royal Observatory in Greenwich, established in 1675 by King Charles II. Led by Royal Astronomer John Flamsteed, it perfected celestial navigation and stellar positions.

-Afterward, visit the Tower Bridge*:

Tower Bridge, a concrete suspension bridge with six lanes, boasts an upper level 42 meters above high tide, featuring a spacious pedestrian walkway with glass windows for breathtaking Thames views. The lower level is for vehicular traffic, and when large vessels pass, the bridge's machinery lifts its 1,000-ton movable decks. The twin towers house stairs, museums, and more, providing panoramic Thames River views. The Tower of London, a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1988, served as a fortress, armory, royal treasury, mint, palace, observatory, refuge, and prison for high-ranking individuals.

12:00 - Lunch

13:00 - Visit Portobello Market, renowned from the movie "Notting Hill," a charming London spot known for its weekday fruit and vegetable stalls. On Saturdays, it becomes a global attraction as an antique market, with three main sections dedicated to antiques and jewelry, food, and clothing. "Flowers and Youth" also filmed here, showcasing the local cuisine. Please note that the market is closed on Thursday afternoons, and dinner arrangements are self-made.

Day 4 London

08:00 - Hotel breakfast

09:00 - Depart by car to Churchill Manor

10:00 - Blenheim Palace is the Duke's residence built by Queen Anne in 1704 to reward the 1st Duke of Marlborough, John Churchill, for his victory over the French and Bavarian invading forces. Blenheim Palace, a Baroque-style building, draws inspiration from various sources. It is the only non-royal and non-religious structure in the UK referred to as a palace.

12:00 - Lunch

13:00 - Drive to Bicester Shopping Village

13:30 - Arrive and enjoy free shopping time: Bicester Village is one of the renowned shopping villages in the UK, also known as a designer outlet village. It's a treasure trove for many celebrities and fashion designers, attracting tourists who visit specifically for shopping before Christmas. Over 90 world-famous brands have outlet stores here, with prices generally around 60% lower than the market prices.

16:30 - Return to London by car

18:00 - Dinner

19:00 - Check into the hotel for rest.





Day 5 London - LegoLand

08:00 - Hotel breakfast

09:00 - Depart by car to Harrods Department Store

Founded by Mr. Charles Henry Harrod in 1834, Harrods Department Store has a history of nearly 180 years and has grown into a globally renowned shopping paradise. Covering 4.5 acres, it features 330 departments offering diverse products and services, including a comprehensive collection of British brands, Harrods' own creations, and all top international luxury brands. Harrods has a palace-like and opulent decorative style, with interior decorations showcasing Egyptian influences, reflecting the Egyptian heritage of its former owner, Mohamed Al-Fayed.

12:00 - Lunch

13:00 - Drive to LEGOLAND

13:30 - Enter LEGOLAND (minimum 3 hours for the visit):

Located in the town of Windsor, Berkshire, LEGOLAND is the world's largest LEGO-themed amusement park. Opened in 1996, the park features miniature replicas of British landmarks constructed from LEGO bricks, including Big Ben, the London Eye, City Hall, and the River Thames. It also includes various themed areas like the Kingdom of the Pharaohs, Viking Land, Knight's Kingdom, and Adventure Land, offering multiple interactive attractions.

16:30 - Return to London by car

18:00 - Dinner

19:00 - Check into the hotel for rest.





Day 6 London - Harry Potter Studio Tour

08:00 - Hotel breakfast

09:00 - Depart by car to Oxford Street and Regent Street

-Oxford Street, a major London shopping hub, spans 1.25 miles with stunning late 18th-century architecture. Hosting 300+ world-brand stores, including flagship fashion brands like Nike Town and Topshop.

-Regent Street, perpendicular to Oxford Street, features diverse shops connecting Oxford Circus and Piccadilly Circus. Notable stores include the world's largest toy store, Wedgwood, Mappin & Webb, and Liberty department store. This charming street evokes a sense of early 20th-century Britain with impeccably dressed upper-middle-class locals.

12:00 - Lunch

13:00 - Drive to Harry Potter Studio Tour

-The Making of Harry Potter studio, opened in 2012 in Leavesden, a London suburb, is approximately a one-hour drive, 22KM away. Formerly a filming location for Harry Potter, it's now a Warner Bros. studio faithfully reproducing iconic scenes with props from the movies and offering interactive experiences. The studio comprises three areas: two indoor sections (school dormitories, magic classrooms, various models) and an outdoor section (the triple-decker bus, street scenes). It's a magical journey for fans.

16:30 - Return to London by car

18:00 - Dinner

19:00 - Check into the hotel for rest.





Day 7 London - Cambridge - Windsor - Airport

08:00 - Hotel breakfast

09:00 - Depart by car to Windsor Town

12:00 - Lunch

13:00 - Continue to Windsor Town

15:00 - Arrive and visit Windsor Castle* (Enter and explore):

-Windsor Castle, an impressive medieval fortress sprawling across 7 hectares, stands as the largest inhabited castle globally, boasting a rich historical tapestry. Within its venerable walls, the castle serves as a custodian to a myriad of treasures belonging to the British royal family, featuring masterpieces by acclaimed artists like da Vinci, Rubens, and Rembrandt. Each room within this majestic abode unfolds as a small yet exquisite art gallery, showcasing the opulence and cultural significance of the royal collections. The castle's architectural grandeur, crafted predominantly from stone, encompasses nearly a thousand rooms, each narrating its unique tale. The expansive grounds surrounding the castle unveil picturesque green lawns and dense forests, creating a tranquil and enchanting setting. Notably, it was within these hallowed walls that William Shakespeare found inspiration to craft his renowned play "The Merry Wives of Windsor," adding another layer of cultural richness to this regal stronghold.
