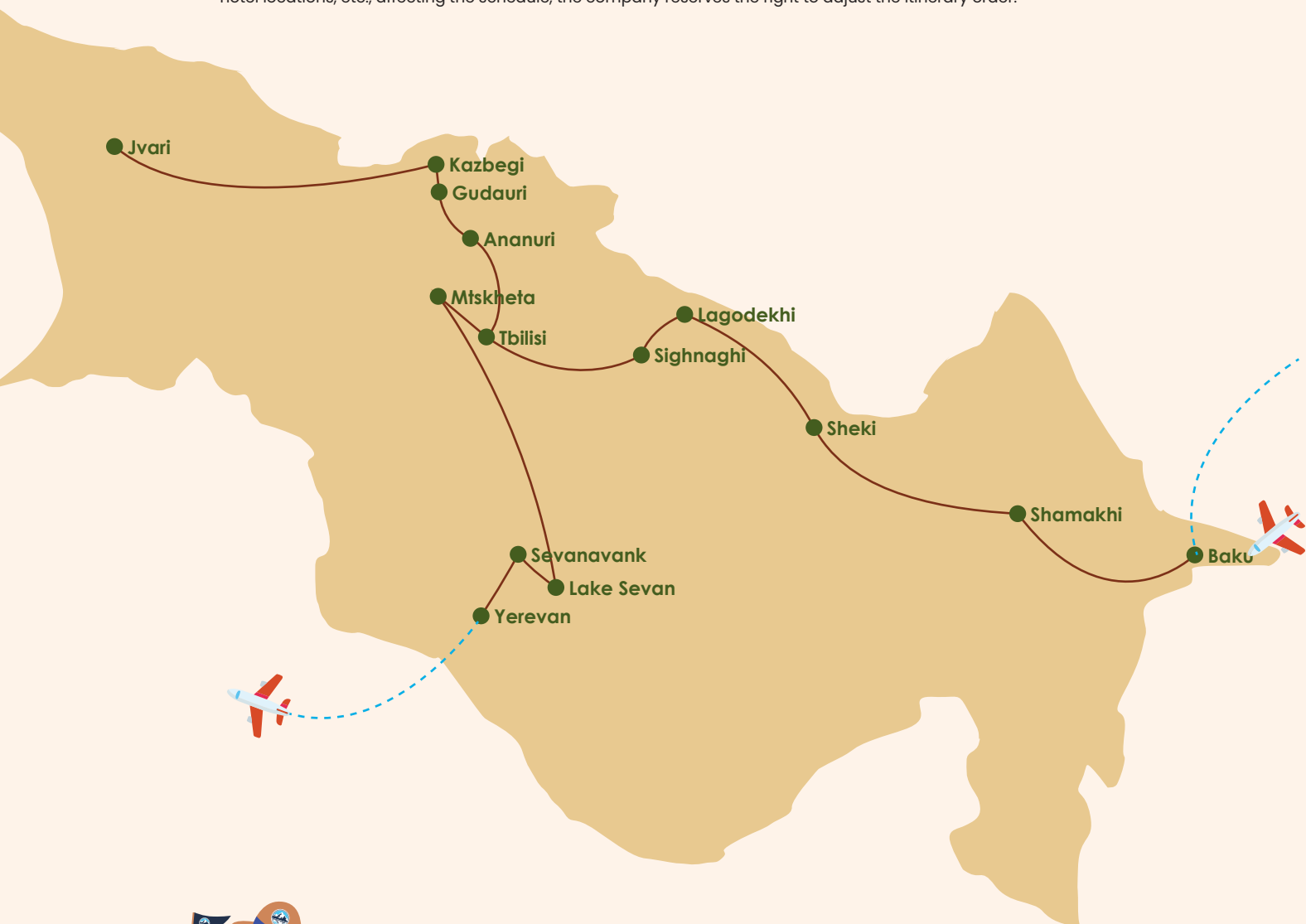

Continue to see the Heydar Aliyev Center (panoramic view / no entrance). Dinner and check in hotel.

After breakfast, proceed to Gobustan explore the famous rock petroglyphs dating back to 10,000 BC. In 2007 was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Continue, visit Gobustan Rock Art Cultural Landscape and Mud volcanoes. After lunch, visit The Ancient Zoroastrian Temple. Also called the "Temple of the Fire" is a religious historical castle in the suburb of Surakhani. Visit the Yanar Dag, an ancient and visually stunning fire which blazes continuously on a hillside for thousands of years. Free at leisure and check in hotel.

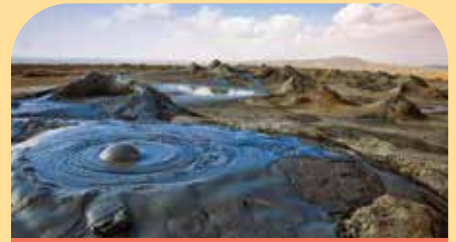

BAKU – SHAMAKHI – SHEKI

After breakfast, make a stop at the Diri Baba Mausoleum. Continue to Shamakha, and have a sightseeing of historical Juma Mosque. Thereafter, make a quick stop at Nohur Lake for great mountain view if the weather & time allows. Driving to Sheki, visit Sheki Medieval fortress, Sheki Khans Palace, built in 1762 by Hussein Khan the interior of the two-storey building is decorated with magnificent frescoes and lit by exquisite stained glass. Visit Caravanserai Sheki. Thereafter, dinner and check in hotel.

SHEKI – LAGODEKHI BORDER – SIGHNAGHI – TBILISI

This morning, across the Lagodekhi border between Azerbaijan to Georgia and meet with the Georgian guide. The Georgian town of Signaghi is located in the eastern part of Kakheti, and is known as the City of Love. Signaghi was also one of Georgia's many stops along the ancient Silk Road. Signaghi is just over an hour away from Tbilisi, which makes it a good escape from the busy life of the city. Many day trips and short excursions travel to Signaghi. The town sits atop a bluff overlooking the Alazani Valley, which is one of Georgia's most famous wine-producing regions. As is typical of Georgia, Signaghi is endowed with significant historic and cultural heritage sites. Its charming cobblestone streets and alleys, restored original nouveau woodwork, and detailed facades give the town a romantic mystique. Billed the City of Love, Signaghi is a popular wedding venue. The wedding chapel here was the first to operate around the clock, and put Signaghi on the map as a destination. Its marriage chapel now hosts ceremonies taking place all hours of the day and night. It is also a frequent venue for traditional Georgian dance recitals, music and craft festivals. Night in Tbilisi.

TBILISI – ANANURI – GUDAURI – KAZBEGI

After breakfast at the hotel pick up for the tour to Ananuri-Gudauri-Kazbegi. This is an excursion to one of the most picturesque regions of Georgia – Kazbegi, along famous Georgian military road. During the excursion tourists will view Jinali water reserve and visit Ananuri fortress, which belongs to XIV-XVII centuries, drive through beautiful Aragvi gorge, via winter ski resort Gudauri, and will cross the Cross path – at altitude 2395 m above the sea level. Enjoying amazing mountain views. Tourists will also taste local mineral water, which contains iron and afterwards arrive to town Stepantsminda, the center of Kazbegi region. This route was used from altar in Ananuri church Kazbegi tour ancient times to connect North Caucasus to the central Georgia. 4x4 drive to the Gergeti trinity church located on altitude 2200 m above the sea level. If you are lucky and weather is clear, you will see mount Kazbegi – 5047 m above the sea level. Overnight in Kazbegi.

KAZBEGI – JVARI – MTSKHETA – TBILISI

Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy breathtaking view from the church that towers over the city of Mtskheta. Continue to Svetitskhoveli Cathedral, known as the burial site of Christ's robe and the second largest church building in the country. The Cathedral has long been the principal Georgian church and remains one of the most venerated places of worship to this day. In the afternoon transfer to Tbilisi. Start exploring Tbilisi. Tbilisi city tour starts at Metekhi plateau, from where is perfect panoramic view to the old city – Narikala fortress, Bath district, Meidan, Kala district, Betlemi district – so tourists can have a look at the whole old city, which they will explore in the next few hours. Here is located also statue of king Vaxhang Gorgasali – founder of Tbilisi. Cable way, it connects new park Rike with Narikala fortress. Few minutes travel by cable car and enjoy magnificent views of Old Tbilisi. From the top station of cable way are views to the old city and botanical garden Fortress Narikala. Chronicles of Georgia Overnight in Tbilisi.

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to Gori. The Uplistsikhe tour is an exciting trip to a unique city carved into volcanic cliffs. It once housed churches, residential buildings, vaults, squares, and streets bustling with life. With a history spanning over 2000 years, it was a place where pagan rituals were once practiced. Later, Christianity replaced the pagan lifestyle, and people began building churches adorned with frescoes that have survived to this day. You can see how people lived in stone cells, observe their household setups, and even explore the secret tunnel. In the very center of the town, standing out against the backdrop of ancient structures, is a large palace built in a distinctive Gothic style. This is the Stalin Memorial Museum, constructed in the 1950s. The museum surrounds the house where, on December 21, 1879, the famous “Kremlin Highlander” was born to shoemaker Vissarion Dzhugashvili. The house, part of the museum complex, is a high-ceilinged stone structure.

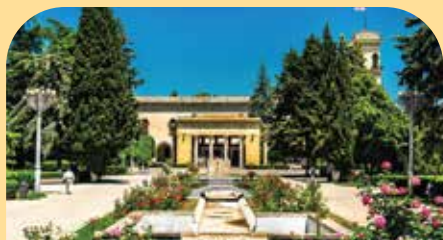

TBILISI – SEVAN – SEVANAVANK – YEREVAN

After breakfast, visit the pearl of Armenia, Lake Sevan. It is considered the largest freshwater lake in the CIS. People often call it the Geghama Sea, as it truly resembles a sea. Gazing far into the horizon, you can see only the Geghama Mountains and the deep blue expanse of the vast lake. Sevan is part of the Sevan National Park and Reserve, which also contains medieval historical monuments. One of the most important sights at Sevan is the Sevanavank Monastery. This monastic complex is located on the peninsula. At one time, the monastery was one of the main religious centers, but over time, it gradually became empty. After visiting Sevan, transfer to Yerevan for an overnight stay.

YEREVAN CITY TOUR

After breakfast, start exploring Yerevan, the pride of Armenia and the largest city in the country. This year, Yerevan celebrates its 2800th anniversary. It's amazing that such a modern city has a history dating back to 782 BC. The tour will take you along the central streets of the city: Mashtots Avenue, Theatre Square, the French Square, City Hall, the Presidential Residence, and the Parliament. One of Yerevan's main attractions is the Cascade—a complex of artistically designed stairways, sculptures, fountains, and flower gardens. The Cascade connects the lower and upper parts of the city. In front of the Cascade, there is a monument to Tamanyan, the great architect of modern Yerevan. Thanks to Tamanyan, we have such a beautiful and harmonious city. The tour of Yerevan concludes with a visit to the Tsitsernakaberd Memorial Complex, commemorating the innocent victims of the 1915 genocide. Visit the Brandy Factory for a brandy tasting. Overnight stay in Yerevan.

YEREVAN – DOHA – KUALA LUMPUR

After breakfast, visit the Garni Pagan Temple, which sits on a cliff overlooking a ravine surrounded by the Garni Gorge. This site offers a view of stunning natural rock formations known as the “Symphony of Stones” or “Basalt Organ.” These rocks form long, hexagonal vertical columns reminiscent of a church organ.

Enjoy lunch at a local house, where you’ll have the chance to participate in a “lavash” making master class. Then, visit the Geghard Monastery, famous for the relics it houses, including the lance that wounded Christ on the cross.

Later, visit the Vernissage flea market, where you’ll have free time for shopping. After dinner, transfer to the airport for your flight back home.
